ICAR's 23rd All India Entrance Re-examination for admission to UG, PG and Ph.D. courses for the Academic Session 2018-19 shall be held in **offline mode (OMR-based)** on **18th and 19th August, 2018** at 56 Examination City Centres all over the country as per the following schedule:

The examination will be **limited to only those candidates who had applied earlier** for ICAR's 23rd All India Entrance Examination conducted in CBT Mode on 22.06.2018 and 23.06.2018 which was subsequently cancelled due to administrative reasons.

The candidates may please note that:

1. Such candidates will be given an opportunity to visit the details filled in by them at the time of making online application. They will be permitted to review the application form previously submitted by them and **make fresh choice(s)** of examination city centres for appearing in the examination.
2. The candidates who had applied earlier, but could not appear in the online examination due to some reason shall also be eligible to appear in the offline examination.
3. The application fee earlier submitted by such candidates shall remain valid for appearing in the offline examination and **need not have to pay fee again.**
4. After re-visiting the online application form for its verification and editing, the candidate shall take a print out of the application and put thumb impression (his left/her right hand) and signature and send its computer generated hard copy, after completing declaration in his/her own handwriting, to COE (Agril. Edn.) by speed/registered post at the **Controller of Examinations (Agril. Edn, COE), Examination Cell, Agricultural Education Division, Room No. 216, Indian Council of Agricultural Research, KrishiAnusandhanBhavan-II, Pusa, New Delhi -110 012.**
5. The candidates will be required to download new e-admit cards from www.icar.org.in and www.icarexam.net

6. The candidates please note that while filling information in OMR answer sheets at the time of offline examination, if the columns for Subject (UG), Major Subject (PG) and Major Subject and Sub-Subject (for Ph.D. exam) are left blank or filled wrongly, the candidate would expose himself/herself to the risk of evaluation under wrong Subject/Major Subject-Group for which candidate himself/herself would be responsible.
7. In the event the candidate leaves the **column for Category** in OMR Answer Sheet blank or fills the category wrongly, the candidate would be evaluated under General Category.

8. The results of the examination are expected to be declared on or after 30/08/2018.
9. No representation for re-evaluation/re-checking shall be entertained. However, the candidate may be allowed to inspect his/her own OMR Answer Sheet along with answer key or given a copy there of, if representation / request to this effect is submitted by the candidate in his or her own handwriting and signature **within 10 days** from the date of declaration of result on ICAR website along with a copy of e-admit card, copy of Application form and Demand Draft of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) drawn in favour of "Secretary, ICAR Education Division Revolving Fund" payable at New Delhi.

10. The schedule for online counselling shall be notified later.

The aspirants for AICE-JRF/SRF(PGS)-2018 re-examination may please note that seats from the accredited universities under the ICAR-AU system have not been received in the sub subjects of Dairy Chemistry (code 8.1), Dairy Microbiology (8.3), Dairy Technology (8.4), Irrigation Water Management Engineering/Irrigation & Drainage Engineering (9.5) and Fish Nutrition & Feed Technology (11.4). Such candidates who had opted for either of these sub subjects and appeared in the relevant Major Subject at the time of online examination (CBT) may check their eligibility for opting some other sub-subject under a major subject group for appearing in the examination. They may refer to item No. 2.0 (degree programmes available for admission) of Information Bulletin of AICE-JRF/SRF(PGS)-2018 re-examination to be made available on ICAR website www.icar.org.in and www.icarexam.net.

The candidates, in their own interest, are advised **NOT TO** visit the website, www.aieea.net, previously meant for online examination in CBT mode for any information and further communication. **They are advised to remain in constant touch with ICAR's website www.icar.org.in only for any further notifications/instructions related to offline examination.
